- There will be a designated quiet space.
- There will be soft drinks available throughout the ball.
- Please get in contact with regards to any dietary/food requirements. We will try to cater to as many dietary requirements as possible.
- If you need an Auto Adrenaline Injector please bring one with you on the night, as the college does not keep a stock of these.
- May Ball Workers will undergo accessibility training to ensure all guests can be supported on the night.
